



WELCOME TO SHERWOOD FOREST RESORT

We are pleased that you chose our resort for your vacation experience.
We certainly hope your time here is enjoyable and that you make plans to return.

To make everyone's experience as pleasant as possible,
please observe the following resort conditions.

You are staying in a forest community with an abundance of natural wildlife.
Bears and raccoons can be uninvited guests, particularly when there is a source of food.



DO NOT feed or interact with any bears you may see. Enjoy viewing bears at a safe distance, but do not approach them. Bears who become dependent on human food or trash often become aggressive and have to be euthanized.



- ALL garbage must be placed **INSIDE the BEAR-PROOF CONTAINERS.**
DO NOT LEAVE GARBAGE BAGS STACKED OUTSIDE OF THE CONTAINERS.
- If your group has exceeded the capacity of the containers, please contact your management company or cabin owner for additional garbage pickup. (Their phone number should be included in your arrival information.)
- Please **KEEP ANY OVERFLOW GARBAGE INSIDE THE CABIN** if the outside container is full.
- DO NOT use the bear-proof containers of other cabins.
- Break down and flatten packaging to conserve space.



The speed limit inside Sherwood Forest Resort is 15 MPH.



Quiet hours in the resort are 11:00 pm to 7:00 am.

- Please be considerate of other guests and full-time residents in the resort. Outside noises carry long distances, especially after dark.
- You risk being evicted if neighboring guests or owners call the sheriff to complain about nuisances.
- Sherwood Forest is under the jurisdiction of the **Sevier County Sheriff's Dept.** Their **non-emergency** phone number is **(865) 453-4668.**



Campfires, fire pits, fireworks, or any type of open flame are NOT PERMITTED in the resort.



- Fireworks are **ILLEGAL** in Sevier County due to the risk of forest fire.
- **Do NOT use charcoal or wood in gas grills.**
- Use only the barbeque grill at the cabin which you have rented.



Please pick up after your pets.
Dogs should be on a leash at all times outside the cabins.
